

Abstract Pre-judging Guidelines

Experimental Biology is a broad scientific meeting. Therefore, abstracts of poster and platform presentations should be written for a broad science audience.

Specialized terms need to be clearly defined; jargon should be minimized. All abstracts competing in poster and platform competitions will be evaluated initially according to the following criteria. Finalists will be notified.

Introduction – Was the question/hypothesis/objective stated clearly?

Method – Was the approach/method for answering the question stated clearly, and is it appropriate to the study?

Results/Conclusion – Were the results clearly stated and placed in their appropriate context?

Communication/Significance – Did the author effectively communicate the significance of the results?
