



PUBLICATIONS COMMITTEE

Scope

- Serve as a liaison between journal Editors and the AAA Board
- Oversee journal budgets and present them to the AAA Board
- Act as an advocate for AAA's journals with the Publisher
- Assist Editors with issues of concern
- Negotiate contracts with Editors and the journal Publisher
- Chair to attend annual publisher meetings
- One representative to attend annual journal board meetings
- Conduct the 3-year reviews of the Editors in Chief of each journal

Membership

6 members: President-elect, Executive director, Chair, 3 Members-at-large, ensuring that both educational and biological research is represented.

On the current Chair's last year of term, the current Chair, with input from the committee, will select the Chair-elect with final approval to be made by the Board of Directors. The Chair-elect can be any member of the AAA (does not have to be a member of the current Publication's Committee).

Appointment

Appointment of members to fill vacancies on the Committee is normally made by the Committee Chair through AAA's call for volunteers application process. Approval of new committee members is managed by the Nominating Committee with final approval made by the Board of Directors.

Meetings

The committee shall meet during the Annual Meeting and at such other times as the business of the Association may require.

Report

The Committee Chair makes an annual report to the Board at the spring meeting, an interim report at the fall meeting, and at any other times as requested.
