

Guidelines for EDUCATION RESEARCH ABSTRACT Submission

Introduction	State the problem that the research addresses.
Aim	State the research aim(s).
Methods	Provide sufficient detail about methods to suggest rigor and expertise. Include information about statistical analysis. Ensure that the methods clearly demonstrate that the data collected and analyzed provide sufficient information to answer the research question. Include IRB review information.
Results	The data presented should sufficiently demonstrate how the research aim(s) has(have) been addressed. If data are currently being collected and yet to be analyzed, please state this. Otherwise provide statistical values.
Discussion and Conclusion	State how the aim(s) has(have) been achieved. Discuss how the data sufficiently met study objectives. Include a conclusion/concluding statements.
